



Day Procedure Centre

Before you arrive

Please attend to the following matters prior to admission:

A Pre-Admission Form needs to be completed and posted, faxed or delivered to the Day Procedure Centre (DPC) so that it is received at least 48 hours before admission.

Please telephone the DPC the day before your procedure to confirm your appointment and check your admission time.

Your specialist will instruct you regarding any special preparation prior to your procedure. Please follow these instructions carefully and do not drink alcohol the day before.

As certain types of anaesthetics may cause drowsiness and impair your mental awareness, please arrange for someone to collect you after your procedure and remain with you overnight.

Ensure your health insurance fund membership is up to date and have books/cards ready to bring with you.

Do not wear make-up, jewellery or nail varnish on the day of admission.

What to bring with you

- wear loose, comfortable attire
- health insurance book or verification
- pharmaceutical entitlement cards
- list of all current medications
- current medication in original container/packet
- Medicare card/pension card/Veterans' Affairs card
- relevant X-rays or other imaging scans and pathology reports
- a favourite toy or game (children)
- do not bring valuables or large sums of money

When you arrive

- Report to the Reception desk of the DPC (see location map and details on back cover)
- The Admissions Clerk will assist you with completing any additional forms (eg. health fund claim forms) and is available to discuss matters of health insurance, account payment procedures and general hospital information.
- A nurse will collect you from the DPC lounge to commence your clinical assessment.

On leaving Hospital

- You will be provided with a personal discharge plan. If you have any questions, please feel free to ask the nursing staff.
- Staff are available to assist with arranging services you may require following your procedure.
