This multidisciplinary approach ensures access to every specialist you need to get the most advanced treatment and support, all within Cabrini. We provide:

- Highly-qualified surgeons, medical/radiation oncologists and dedicated breast care nurses
- Access to clinical trials (if appropriate)
- Free information sessions for patients, families, carers and friends
- Diagnostic facilities including 3D mammogram, Ultrasound, Nuclear Medicine, PET, MRI and CT
- Second opinion service
- Genetic counselling
- Onsite chemotherapy centre (Malvern/Brighton)
- Symptom and Urgent Review Clinic – dedicated clinic you can call or visit to help you with questions you have about your cancer symptoms or side-effects

Coordinated care, tailored for you

As a breast cancer patient at Cabrini, you can be assured you will have access to personalised, supportive care during treatment, rehabilitation and recovery.

Once your doctor refers you to the Cabrini Breast Cancer Care service, and before your treatment begins, you will be partnered with a breast care nurse.

Cabrini's specialised breast care nurses will assist with the coordination of your care and provide important information to you and your family every step of the way.

They can assist with referrals support, advice and information about treatment and processes. They can also help to connect you with other members of the team, such as a dietitian, psychologist or lymphoedema physiotherapist.

Cabrini's breast care nurses are available for free consultation before, during and after treatment.

Additional services

We offer a Breast Cancer Rehabilitation Program and a Living Well with Secondary Breast Cancer Program. These eight-week exercise and education programs provide specialist support for people with breast cancer. Inclusive of an initial appointment with a rehabilitation physician and a physiotherapist, patients receive a customised exercise program to be completed under specialist supervision.

Both programs encourage participants to openly discuss and ask questions about possible treatment side-effects, fatigue management, return to work strategies and issues of sleep, sexuality and psychological flexibility.

The Maintenance Breast Group Exercise Program is specifically designed for those who have completed the Breast Cancer Rehabilitation Program and would like ongoing support to continue to exercise.

We also offer a number of other support services including:

- Look Good Feel Better program – helps boost confidence and minimise the appearance of treatment side-effects
- Managing Cancer Workshop – an education and support program for people with cancer, their families and friends
- Cabrini wig room – hair stylists will help you choose a wig and will cut it to suit your facial features
- Support groups
