


# Cabrini Australia fact sheet

### **CABRINI MALVERN**

Established in 1948, this 508-bed acute care hospital provides a wide range of services including cardiac care, day procedures, day oncology, emergency care, hospital-in-the-home, intensive care, maternity, paediatric (children's) care, medical imaging and pathology.

### **CABRINI BRIGHTON**

Established in 2002, this hospital has 138 beds across three wards including acute surgical, acute medical and rehabilitation. It has five operating theatres, a day oncology unit, high dependency unit, endoscopy, sleep centre, onsite medical imaging and pathology, specialist consulting suites and 24-hour medical coverage.

### **CABRINI RESIDENTIAL AGED CARE**

Established in 2001, this is home to 90 residents in Ashwood. Residents' wellbeing and quality of life are enhanced by a range of social, recreational, spiritual and emotional support and activities. We provide care for a range of needs and have an 11-bed secure unit.

### **CABRINI PALLIATIVE CARE**

Established in 1999, this 22-bed specialist palliative care hospital in Prahran offers a wide range of services including medical support, nursing, pastoral care, counselling, allied health services, music therapy and art therapy. Many more patients receive care and support from the consultation service, outpatient clinic and home care program. Indeed, over 7000 palliative care home visits were made to 727 people in our community in 2019-20.

### **OUT OF HOSPITAL CARE**

Our out of hospital care services include Hospital in the Home, rehabilitation outpatients, Rehabilitation and Therapy in the Home, chronic disease programs and private allied health sessions. Delivering care in our clinics and, where suitable, in patients' homes, ensures we can continue to provide clinical care beyond the walls of our hospitals to keep our patients recovering and well.



### **CABRINI TECHNOLOGY**

Operating in 18 locations within Australia and New Zealand, employing 550 staff, Cabrini Technology Group (CTG) provides vendor neutral world-class support for technology used in healthcare, disability, government and enterprise for more than 700 organisations in Australia and New Zealand. AxisHealth is a part of Cabrini Technology Group that imports, manufactures, distributes and sells medical capital equipment and consumables to hospitals, aged care and primary care sectors.

### **CABRINI RESEARCH**

Cabrini Research supports new and innovative clinical and translational research that will improve outcomes for patients and aligns with our clinical services. Clinician and academic researchers oversee a diverse research program that covers the full translational research spectrum, from lab based discoveries and clinical trials to clinical implementation. Areas of research include cancer, surgery, arthritis, back pain, health service delivery, nursing, allied health, palliative care, psycho-oncology, intensive care and emergency medicine.

### **CABRINI CANCER INSTITUTE**

Opened in April 2021, the Cabrini Cancer Institute is a new purpose built facility dedicated to advancing translational research and clinical trials, and incorporates a state-of-the-art exercise research laboratory that will examine how exercise can improve cancer patient outcomes and quality of life. Also housed within the Institute, is the Cabrini Cancer Exercise and Wellness Centre. This dedicated facility will provide a relaxing environment that focusses on cancer exercise and wellness to support cancer patients and their carers throughout their journey. As one of Australia's leading providers of cancer services, the integration of the Cabrini Cancer Institute within the Cabrini Malvern hospital allows researchers and clinicians to better work together, developing breakthroughs to deliver better health outcomes for all cancer patients.

### **CABRINI OUTREACH ASYLUM SEEKER HEALTH SERVICES**

The Cabrini Outreach Asylum Seeker Health Services provide a range of free primary care, specialist mental health care, psychosocial support and health waiver programs for people seeking asylum in the North Western area of Melbourne, with recent expansion into the regional areas of Shepparton and Mildura. Services are delivered by a mix of employed and pro bono staff. Medicare-ineligible people seeking asylum receive priority access to our services.

### **CABRINI OUTREACH INTERNATIONAL PROGRAMS**

Believing strong and collaborative community partnerships are the best way to address social and economic disadvantage, we endeavour to form long term relationships and to leverage our human, financial and material resources to support our overseas partners. Internationally, we focus on strengthening the delivery of health care in the developing world, particularly in Papua New Guinea, Ethiopia and Swaziland. We also work closely with Cabrini Immigrant Services New York, who work to provide care for similar populations to those of our asylum seeker health services.
