The new Gandel Wing is a \$120m investment in the health of current and future patients. The result of nine years of planning and development, the new wing will help Cabrini provide even better services for our patients.

Ground floor:

Even better emergency care

TO CONTINUE TO FULFILL OUR ROLE in providing rapid, high-quality emergency care to residents of our local community, we have expanded our emergency department (ED). Our redeveloped ED includes 19 new beds with ten acute treatment bays and nine private rooms. It has integrated specialised medical imaging equipment, including a CT scanner, general x-ray room and ultrasound room. This new medical imaging capability improves the speed of diagnosis, which in-turn enables our ED specialists to swiftly determine the best treatment for patients.

Level 1:

Even better cardiac care

CARDIAC CARE IS CONTINUALLY EVOLVING, with new technologies, processes, techniques and procedures to help patients recover sooner. The cardiac ward of the Gandel Wing will provide a multidisciplinary approach to cardiac care, using the latest equipment and treatment methods.

Level 2:

Even better maternity care

OUR EXPANDED MATERNITY & BABIES SERVICE means more children can safely begin their lives at Cabrini. Our maternity service is a valued community asset, with generations of children starting their lives at Cabrini Malvern. New mothers will be accommodated in one of 19 private rooms (all with double beds). Our maternity service complements the Cabrini Mother and Baby Centre, which provides multidisciplinary care during pregnancy and beyond.

Level 3:

Even better care for older people

A HIGH PROPORTION OF OUR PATIENTS are elderly, frail and suffer from cognitive impairment, which relates to the full scope of memory and thinking difficulties that can limit a person's ability to respond accordingly with his or her environment. In the hospital setting, cognitive impairment often leads to increased anxiety for patients and their loved ones. A purpose-built ward environment will enable our staff and doctors to better meet the needs of this complex group of patients.

Levels 4 and 5:

Even better cancer treatment

CABRINI CONTINUES TO BE A LEADER in cancer treatment, with comprehensive diagnostic, surgical and medical oncology care, as well as specialist palliative care facilities. The Gandel Wing includes a radiotherapy facility, with linear accelerators to deliver radiation therapy, and a mapping CT capability for medical imaging. An integrated, comprehensive, diagnostic and radiotherapy facility means patients can have all of their cancer treatment in one familiar place. The Gandel Wing will provide patients receiving oncology treatment with enhanced comfort and privacy, including specially designed infusion pods to improve the patient experience.

Level 6:

Even better care for respiratory and medical specialties

OUR NEW RESPIRATORY AND MEDICAL SPECIALTIES WARD is located on the top storey of the building. This ward provides specialised facilities to help us manage care for patients who have respiratory and infectious illnesses, such as influenza.
