# The perceived hospital experience for children with ASD

The 'busyness' of the hospital environment can be disrupting and upsetting for children, in particular those with ASD, in addition to

- disruption of the child's routine
- lengthy waiting times
- dealing with unfamiliar people
- strange surroundings, tastes and smells

Identify measures which could be introduced into Cabrini to provide an autism-aware environment for children and their families.

# Study recommendations

- Enhancing communication with patients, families and staff
- Early identification of ASD in children
- Minimising anxiety and sensory triggers in children
- Training and education of staff in relation to ASD



## Cabrini autism-aware initiatives

- Paediatric pre-admission clinic
- Individually tailored care plans
- Virtual ward tour
- Communication cloud and bedside communication boards
- Sensory toolboxes
- Daily quiet time
- Staff education
- Considerations to hospital policies and procedures



### Virtual tour

- The virtual tour is a 360° view of our paediatric ward
- Designed to give children and their families a chance to 'walkthrough' prior to coming in for a scheduled hospital stay









# Daily quiet time

- Quiet time in the paediatric ward occurs between 1pm and 3pm daily
- This time benefits both patients, families and staff







## **Sensory toolboxes**

- Partnership with TLC For Kids
- The Sensory Box Program is a pilot program aimed to suit the specific needs of children with sensory disorders, particularly those with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD)
