The 12-month program and 15-month nurse/midwives program enables midwives to consolidate and progress their skills in a supported environment.

APPLICATION PROCESS

All applications must be received via cabrini.com.au/work-with-us/graduate-midwifery

Information for the application process for all applicants:

- In your CV ensure that each of your clinical placements includes the length, month, year, facility, length of placement
- Two professional referees.
 - At least one of these references must be from your most recent clinical placement and from Birthing Suite
 - Referees must have full name, title, phone number and email address
- Most recent certified copy of your academic transcript including the grading legend/key page
- Two most recent Clinical Placement Reports. One of these reports must be from the Birthing Suite. If you are a double degree one report can be from an acute medical or surgical undergraduate placement
- Shortlisted candidates will be emailed an invite to participate in Cabrini Graduate Discovery and Assessment Day. This will involve a face-to-face interview, team assessments, a hospital tour, and an opportunity to network with our current and past graduates, nurse managers and other Cabrini leaders.
