At Cabrini, we are passionate about providing you with the support, care and compassion you need to bring your baby safely into the world.


Our highly-skilled obstetricians and dedicated midwives, nurses and allied health staff will guide you through the birthing process and assist with the transition into parenthood.

The deluxe private rooms have double beds, allowing partners to stay with you following the birth of your baby. All rooms have private ensuites with purpose-designed baby baths.

Our special care nursery helps support babies who require extra attention, under the close supervision of our specialist paediatricians.

Cabrini is proud to partner with Safer Care Victoria to ensure all women are screened for their risk of stillbirth. Together, we are working to achieve better outcomes for women, babies and their families.

Rooming-in

Rooming-in allows you and your baby to remain together. It helps to build confidence in caring for your baby, establish a breastfeeding routine and promotes bonding between you, your partner and your new baby.

Visiting hours

Our maternity unit visiting hours are between 3 - 8 pm. Talk to your family and friends to determine the best time for you to receive visitors. It is a good idea to have one person responsible for co-ordinating when family and friends will come to see you and your baby. All we ask is that the number of visitors at any one time is limited to two or three people. If any of your visitors are unwell, please ask them to delay their visit.

Breastfeeding clinic



CLASSES AND WORKSHOPS

Cabrini offers a range of informative and interactive classes* to help you prepare for pregnancy, childbirth and care of your new baby.

Early pregnancy

Learn how to enjoy a healthy pregnancy in this class facilitated by our specialist physiotherapists. Understand how to prevent back and pelvic pain, poor bladder control and learn exercises that are safe and beneficial throughout your pregnancy.

Mums in training[#]

Maternity exercise and pilates class. Enjoy a 1:1 consultation with a specialist physiotherapist.

Positive birthing

Designed for first time expectant parents, this class runs on a weekend day of your choice. Meet and learn from experienced Cabrini midwives, educators and other mothers.

Birth skills[#]

Facilitated by our specialist physiotherapists, this practical birth skills class is designed to empower you and your support person throughout your upcoming labour.

Caesarean birth

YOUR PLANNING GUIDE

1 Book a tour

We would be pleased to show you around Cabrini's maternity unit. On your 30 minute tour you will see our birth suites, post-natal rooms and special care nursery. Our tours are hosted by an experienced midwife, who will be able to answer your individual questions and provide further information about our services and classes.

2 Find an accredited Cabrini obstetrician

Cabrini's highly-skilled and experienced obstetricians will assist and guide you through your pregnancy.

3 GP referral

Booking into Cabrini is easy; just ask your general practitioner to refer you to your preferred Cabrini obstetrician.

4 Meet your obstetrician

Discuss your expectations. Take a list of all your questions.

Anything you wish to know about your pregnancy, the birth and your baby, your health concerns and any financial queries.

Discuss your private health insurance coverage with your obstetrician. Always ask about out-of-pocket expenses. Will there be any? How much? If you have any questions afterwards, contact your health insurer. If you don't have health insurance, that's ok, we have the Cabrini self-funded maternity package for those uninsured.

5 Book to have your baby at Cabrini

Private health insurance

Discuss your private health insurance coverage with your obstetrician.

Always ask about out-of-pocket expenses. Will there be any? How much?

If you still have questions, contact your private health insurance company.

Cabrini self-funded maternity package

No private health insurance? No problem.

The Cabrini self-funded maternity package is designed for patients who do not have private health insurance, providing them with access to the highest quality, obstetrician-led care, supported by experts in midwifery, lactation, nursing and physiotherapy.

Cabrini self-funded maternity package includes:

- Accommodation in the maternity unit with 24 hour midwifery care
- Midwifery care of the mother and baby during labour and birth
- Postnatal breastfeeding support group
- Individual postnatal session with our physiotherapist
- Breastfeeding clinic if required – one attendance
- All meals provided for the mother
- Local telephone calls
- WiFi access

Medical practitioner charges

All obstetricians, paediatricians, anaesthetists, surgical assistants and other doctors are private practitioners and will invoice separately from the hospital package. These costs are not included in the Cabrini self-funded maternity package.

FAQs

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1 How long will I be in hospital for?

After a normal birth or an elective caesarean section, you are welcome to stay for four nights. If an emergency caesarean section is required this is increased to five nights.

2 Is a private room guaranteed?

All our rooms in the maternity ward are private rooms with a double bed and ensuite, allowing your partner or a support person to stay with you should you wish.

3 What level is Cabrini's nursery?

Our special care nursery provides specialised care by paediatricians and nursing staff and is classified as Level 3 under the new classification system in Victoria.

4 How do I book into Cabrini?

Your obstetrician will arrange the hospital booking following your first visit with them.

5 Do I need to be booked under an obstetrician to come to Cabrini?

All patients need to be booked under a Cabrini obstetrician to deliver with us. We have a list of our obstetricians on page 11 of this guide.

6 Does Cabrini provide classes and how do I book in?

Cabrini Maternity provides a choice of antenatal classes to suit everyone. They range from Early Pregnancy Classes (which focus on health and wellbeing during the pregnancy), Birth and Beyond Classes, positive birthing classes and supervised exercise classes. Also popular are our Baby First Aid and Grandparent classes. These can be booked online at cabrini.com.au/maternity

7 Is there parking onsite and how much does it cost?

Undercover parking is available at Cabrini for patients and visitors. The cost is \$25 per day (maximum).

8 What are the maternity visiting hours?

Our maternity unit visiting hours are between 3 - 8 pm. Friends and family are welcome to visit during the afternoon and early evening at a time that suits you.

9 Other than the cost of the obstetrician, are there any other expected out-of-pocket expenses?

There may be additional costs for ultrasound scans and pathology during your stay. There may also be additional out-of-pocket costs for attending specialists such as an anaesthetist, paediatrician or assisting surgeon should you have a caesarean birth.

10 Are meals for my partner or support person included in my/our stay?

Your partner or support person is welcome to order meals from our in-room menu at an additional fee.

11 Is there a lactation consultant available?

Many of our midwives are trained lactation specialists who can assist you during your stay. We also have a Breastfeeding Clinic you can attend after you have returned home. We also have a specialist GP lactation consultant who works in our Mother and Baby Centre.

About Cabrini

We've come a long way since 1948

The Cabrini story in Australia began in 1948 when ten Sisters arrived in Melbourne from Italy to take over St Benedict's hospital in Malvern. They were tasked with caring for Italians arriving in Australia following the Second World War.
